| <b>Friday, February 4, 2011</b> | All first, second and third-place state winners' artwork from each age category <b>must be received by C.O.B. at the NASAO Center office.</b> |
| <b>Week of February 7, 2011</b> | United States national judging.   |

## **RULES:**

- Each state should send the first, second and third-place winners' artwork in each age category to the NASAO Center. **NO TIES!** One piece of art for each place.
- Please check all ages/birth dates. Artwork that is submitted to the NASAO Center as a winner in an incorrect age category will not be eligible for national judging. Each piece of artwork submitted to the national competition **MUST** have at least the **YEAR** of the child's birth on the entry form (it is recognized that some people may not want to give a specific date), in addition to listing the child's age.

### Birth Dates for the 2011 Art Contest

- **Group I - Junior Category** (Date of birth between January 1, 2001 and December 31, 2004)
- **Group II - Intermediate Category** (Date of birth between January 1, 1997 and December 31, 2000)
- **Group III - Senior Category** (Date of birth between January 1, 1993 and December 31, 1996)

## **SUBMIT (please note what to submit):**

- **Cover letter** with:
  - a) the first, second and third-place winner's name, address, telephone and age in each age category, and
  - b) the total number of entries your state received for the entire contest.
- **Scanned jpeg or gif file** of the state's first, second, and third place winners. These files will be used for future art contest information.

Mail the following:

- State's submission of the **1<sup>st</sup>, 2<sup>nd</sup>, and 3<sup>rd</sup> place artwork** in each category to the NASAO Center:
- **Self-addressed/stamped envelope, at least 11 x 17**, if you would like to have the artwork returned to your state. Do not send tubes. Check envelope for correct size and postage required for the artwork to be returned. Failure to do this will result in artwork remaining at NASAO.
- **One set of 8-1/2" x 11"** laminated color photocopies of the state's first place winner only. (**DO NOT LAMINATE ORIGINAL ARTWORK**). The national winners will be showcased in the NASAO exhibit at EAA AirVenture in Oshkosh next summer. We also display copies of some of the state winners' artwork at Oshkosh and other events (but only if already laminated).
