

**REQUEST FOR QUALIFICATIONS  
DESIGN & CONSTRUCTION ENGINEERING SERVICES  
19<sup>TH</sup> STREET BRIDGE REPLACEMENT**

The City of Kearney is requesting the services of an engineering firm to perform professional services including design, construction administration, and inspection for the 19<sup>th</sup> Street Bridge Replacement Project - BRM-3400 (431). The project is approximately 40-50' wide by 60-80' long and located on East 19<sup>th</sup> Street, approximately 1,500 feet east of 33 Highway; Kearney, MO 64060. This project has been allocated a portion of the funding through the 2013 Bridge Replacement and Rehabilitation Program (BR) by the Mid-America Regional Council. A DBE goal of 7% has been established for this project.

To be considered for these consulting services, please submit a Letter of Interest limited to no more than five (5) pages, and one (1) copy of your firm's Statement of Qualifications, including the following criteria (per 23 CFR 172 Administration of Engineering & Design Related Service Contracts and RSMo 8.285 through 8.291). Firms that have a current Statement of Qualifications on file with the City, submitted within the past year, are allowed to submit only a Letter of Interest:

1. Experience in planning, design, construction engineering, and inspections services for bridge replacement projects;
2. Experience in design, construction engineering, and inspections services on STP/BR projects in accordance with the MoDOT LPA Manual regarding Construction Testing and Inspection;
3. Experience working with and meeting the requirements of the Federal Highway Administration and Missouri Department of Transportation (District 4), and the Mid-America Regional Council (MARC);
4. The capacity and capability of the firm to perform the work in question, including specialized services, within the time limitations fixed for the completion of the project;
5. Persons or team to be assigned to the project, including backgrounds of those individuals;
6. Recently completed or currently active projects, similar in scope to the proposed project;
7. The past record of performance of the firm with respect to such factors as quality of work, control of costs, and ability to meet schedules;
8. The firm's proximity to and familiarity with the area in which the project is located; and
9. The firm's past experience and history with the City of Kearney

The City has established the following general timeline for the selection process:

1. June 9, 2011      Send out letter to consultants and begin advertisement
2. July 7, 2011      Closing date for all letters of interest and statements of qualifications
3. July 21, 2011     Select consultant
4. August 4, 2011    Negotiate cost
5. August 18, 2011   Finalize contract

We encourage DBE firms to submit letters of interest as prime consultants for any projects they feel can be managed by their firm. DBE firms must be listed in the MRCC DBE Directory located on MoDOT's website at [www.modot.gov](http://www.modot.gov), in order to be counted as participation towards an established DBE Goal.

It is required that your firm's Statement of Qualification (RSMo 8.285 through 8.291) and an Affidavit of Compliance with the federal work authorization program along with a copy of your firm's E-Verify Memorandum of Understanding (15 CSR 60-15.020) be submitted with your firm's Letter of Interest.

Statements of Qualifications must be submitted by 5:00 PM on July 7, 2011. Late and/or incomplete submittals will not be considered.
