**REQUEST FOR QUALIFICATIONS**  
**PROFESSIONAL ENGINEERING SERVICES**

The City of Greenville requests qualifications for professional engineering services for the Old Greenville Recreational Trail Project.

The project, funded by the Missouri Department of Transportation, Transportation Enhancement Fund, is the construction of a bicycle/walking trail connecting Old Greenville to the City of Greenville. This connection with the Ozark trail will provide users the opportunity to visit Greenville and also utilize the Old Greenville Campground without need to travel a highway. Completion of this project will provide access to a recreational facility and enhance the quality of life for the ones that make use of the Trail. The proposed Trail will be approximately 3.25 miles in length. The Trail will also provide loops at the City of Greenville and at the Old Greenville Campground. The Trail will be eight (8) feet wide with a three (3) inch deep asphalt surface. The Trail will cross Mark Twain National Forest land.

The project is located in Wayne County on property owned by the US Corps of Engineers and will follow the Local Public Agency Manual.

Information provided to the city must include at a minimum:

- 1) The specialized experience and technical competence of the firm with respect to construction design, specification preparation or related work;
- 2) The capacity and capability of the firm to perform the work in question, including specialized services, within a period of 12 months beginning;
- 3) The past record of performances of the firm with respect to such factors as control of costs, quality of work and ability to meet schedules;
- 4) The firm's proximity to and familiarity with the area in which the project is located and;
- 5) Reference from previous clients of related work with the firm within the past five years.

The firm will be selected based on the above qualifications.

The above information should be submitted and received no later than August 31, 2009, 4:00 p.m., to the City Clerk, Greenville City Hall, P.O. Box 175, Greenville, Missouri 63944. Submissions will be evaluated by the City September 14, 2009. For more information contact the City Clerk at (573) 224-3911.
