Dear Industry Partners,

On July 1, 2016, the Joint Committee on Administrative Rules published in the Missouri Register a public notice indicating all **EXISTING** rules promulgated by the Missouri Department of Transportation are open for review. A copy of this notice is included as well as a link to the Missouri Register.

The Missouri General Assembly instituted this review under Section 536.175 RSMo. requiring each state agency to review its rules in the Code of State Regulations (CSR). There is a 60-day public comment period ending August 31, 2016.

There are numerous rules open for public comment and this correspondence is intended to start the discussion with industry specifically concerning the rules directly impacting the construction of road and bridge projects in Missouri.

The Construction and Materials and External Civil Rights Divisions intend to jointly start open discussion with industry in the coming days for the following rules:

- 7 CSR 10-8 Disadvantaged Business Enterprise Program
- 7 CSR 10-10 Contractor Performance Rating to Determine Responsibility
- 7 CSR 10-15 Contractor Prequalification
- 7 CSR 10-18 Contractor Disqualification for Misconduct
- 7 CSR 10-19 Contractor Drug Testing Program
- 7 CSR 10-23 Technician Certification Program
- 7 CSR 10-26 Arbitration and Mediation of Construction Disputes

While the public comment period has just opened and the number and nature of comments are unknown, MoDOT has provided DRAFT revisions we believe are necessary thus far for industry discussion and comment. We have attached a summary sheet simplifying the revisions. We have also provided the following link to review the rules listed above in detail with DRAFT revisions.


