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Sealed bids for the Construction of sidewalks, stairs, ramps, planters, and drainage, to the City of Gainesville Missouri, will be received until 2:00 p.m., Friday, October 23rd, 2009, at City Hall, 208 4th Street and Harlin Drive, Gainesville, MO 65655.

A certified check, cashier's check, or bid bond executed by the bidder and approved surety company in the amount of five (5) percent of the bid shall be submitted with each proposal.

One set of Plans and the Project Manual can be secured from HOOD-RICH, Inc., Architects and Engineers, 801 South Glenstone, Springfield, Missouri, 65802, upon the deposit of \$ 100.00 by bidders check payable to Hood-Rich, Inc., Architects and Engineers, 801 South Glenstone, Springfield, Missouri. This Deposit will be returned upon the return of the plans and project manual in good condition within thirty (30) days after the bid opening. If Bidders desire to have an additional set of plans and the project manual, they may obtain an additional set at a cost \$ 100.00 which will not be refundable. All plans and project manuals shall remain the property of Hood-Rich, Inc. and shall be returned to Hood-Rich, Inc. upon completion of bidding.

Contractors wishing to have plans and project manuals mailed to them shall pay a non-refundable shipping and handling cost of \$35.00 per set.

The general contractor shall be required to pay the Prevailing Wage Order for Ozark County as determined by the Missouri Division of Labor Standards Annual Wage Order, included in the specifications.

The general contractor shall be required to pay the Prevailing Wage as determined by the branch of construction wage determination Wage and Hour Division U.S. Department of Labor. 200 Constitutional Ave. NW. Washington, D.C. 20210, included in the specifications.

The general contractor will be required to pay the highest wage rate on each discipline of work whether it be the Missouri Division of Labor Standards or the Federal Wage rate.

Pursuant to Missouri Revised Statute Section 290.560, whenever there is a period of excessive unemployment in Missouri, all public works projects or improvements for any governmental unit shall employ only Missouri laborers and laborers from nonrestrictive states on such projects or improvements, unless such laborers are unavailable or incapable of performing the particular type of work involved and this fact is certified by the contractor and approved by the contracting officer for the governmental unit, then at this time other laborers may be used.

The owner reserves the right to reject any and all bids and to waive any informalities in bidding. No bids may be withdrawn for a period of thirty (30) days after the bid date.

The City of Gainesville, Missouri hereby notifies all bidders that it will affirmatively ensure that in any contract entered into pursuant to this advertisement, disadvantaged business enterprises will be afforded full opportunity to submit bids in response to this invitation and will not be discriminated against on the grounds of race, color, or national origin in consideration for an award. The Disadvantaged Business Enterprise goal for this project is 8%.
