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## NOTICE TO BIDDERS

Sealed Bids addressed to the City of Rock Hill-Brownbert Road/Steger Signal Project will be received by the City Clerk of the City of Rock Hill, 320 W. Thornton Ave, Rock Hill, Missouri until 11:00 a.m. on October 28, 2011 and thereafter will be publicly opened and read aloud.

The proposed work includes the furnishing of materials, tools, equipment and labor necessary for the installation of a new traffic signal at the intersection of Rock Hill Road and Brownbert Lane as well as grading, paving and drainage to construct new sidewalks, curb ramps, decorative medians, road widening as well as entrance paving and marking in accordance with the plans and specifications and other items identified in the contract documents. The Contractor is responsible for all items of work necessary to complete the project.

Each bid must be accompanied by a cashier's check, or a Bid Bond executed by the Bidder and an approved surety company and payable to the City of Rock Hill in an amount not less than five percent (5%) of the sum total of the base bid. Copies of the plans and specifications may be obtained from Rock Hill City Hall, located at 320 W. Thornton Ave, Rock Hill, Missouri 63119, upon receipt of payment of a \$75 non-refundable fee for each set. **Please make checks payable to the City of Rock Hill.**

The applicable wage rates for this project has been predetermined as required by law and are set forth in the appendix of the Contract Documents. Not less than the highest prevailing hourly wages shall be paid to all workmen performing work under this Contract.

The DBE goal for this project is 18% of the total contract amount.

All requests for clarifications on these bidding documents must be received in writing at least one week prior to the bid opening, or addressed at the pre-bid meeting. All Prime Contractors must be on MODOT's Approved Contractor Listing seven (7) days prior to bid opening and the DBE Sub-Contractors must be on the MRCC DBE Directory prior to Bidding.

A Performance Bond and Payment and Materials Bond are required.

The City of Rock Hill may award a contract based upon the lowest responsive, responsible bid. The City of Rock Hill reserves the right to reject any and all bids, or to waive informalities therein. No bidder may withdraw their bid for a period of ninety (90) calendar days from and after the date named for the opening of the bids.

The City of Rock Hill hereby notifies all bidders that it will affirmatively ensure that in any contract entered into pursuant to this advertisement, disadvantaged business enterprises will be afforded full opportunity to submit bids in response to this invitation and will not be discriminated against on the grounds of race, color, or national origin in consideration for an award.
