CLARIFICATIONS:

- 1) It has been brought to our attention from a few sources that MoDot expects the contractor to include an anti-strip agent in the oil that will be used for the plant mix oil material. We do not have a problem doing this as long as it is specified in the bid documents, which it is not. To just add it in to our costs without knowing our competitors are doing the same is not feasible it could be the difference in being the low bidder or not. Would it be possible for MoDot to release an addendum addressing this issue so that everyone is on the same page as to what MoDot is expecting, thank you.

There is not a requirement on this bid for the contractor to add anti-strip. He has read the specification correctly. There have been discussions about this, but no resolution was reached on this matter. We have differing opinions about using anti-strip or different asphalt, but the contractor will need to use their expertise to determine the correct method to make the product meet our expectations.
