



referrals. These partners could include heavy highway contractors, community based organization, etc.

4. Please clarify the types of services/offerings you are looking for the Offeror to provide under Statement Work; Section (2); items (A) 1 and 2; page 5? This will be based on the types of activities the Offeror will utilize to prepare minority, female and economically disadvantaged for employment in the heavy highway industry. This could include hands on training, classroom instruction, etc. What programs are the Offeror going to provide to help educate the individuals, GED, classroom training, etc. What areas of heavy highway training will the individuals receive? For example, what is your well detailed curriculum trying to achieve?
5. Is one of MoDOT's evaluation criteria the lowest price/cost or "best value? Could you clarify the formula on page 17; item c; Evaluation Criteria? What is the lowest responsive price (where does this come from) and what is compared price (where does this come from)? The proposal with the lowest price will receive twenty (20) points for the cost criteria. The lowest price will be divided by the price (compared price) of each additional proposal and multiplied by twenty (20) to determine the number of points for cost that each of the proposal will receive.
6. Are you expecting the Offeror to use an assessment tool or skills evaluation instrument for service items (A) 1 and 2 under Scope of Work? The Offeror should have an assessment tool for each of the services they provide to determine the success of the services.
7. Are the individuals receiving services under this contract current employees of MoDOT or where will the individuals come from? Offeror will locate minority, female and economically disadvantaged individual in the community where the services are being offered.
8. Will the Offeror be performing services under the contract at MoDOT locations or are you expecting the Offeror to provide the facility for training/services? Offeror will provide their own training locations, which should be outlined in the proposal.
9. Where will the services be delivered, e.g., St. Louis, Kansas City, Jeff City, etc.? How much travel do you anticipate? The Offeror will provide training locations. The Offeror will make the determination where their services will be provided and can be in more than one location throughout the state. Travel will be based on Offerors program and how the administer their program.

9. What company currently holds the contract for these services; is there an incumbent? If so, may offerors have access to their contract, prices, etc.? This information will need to be requested through MoDOT's open records request. The policy and procedures may be obtained at the link below.
