Does the contractor have to be registered or licensed with the City of St. Louis?

MoDOT Response:

Since this is a state project on state property the contractor does not need to be licensed with the St Louis City Building Department as a demolition contractor. No building demolition permit or business license is required to be obtained other than the state business registration requirements listed in the bid documents. However, to be in compliance with federal air pollution regulations, the contractor is required to notify the St Louis City Air Pollution authority of the demolition work since the St Louis City Health Department has been delegated the authority to enforce the Federal Clean Air Act by the US EPA. The air pollution notification requirement is detailed in Exhibit E of the bid documents.
