2.0 The Commission does not warrant that the above listing or the depiction of utility lines or facilities on other bidding documents are complete or accurately reflect either all utilities or their precise locations within or adjacent to the project limits or the status of any relocation work.

3.0 Laclede Gas has a 16” gas main on the south side of existing Manchester Road that is in conflict with road construction west of Sarala to east of Centeroyal. The contractor is advised that his work schedule will reflect the following temperature restrictions stated by Laclede Gas, which is supplied to the contractor for their information and planning. As the 16” gas main is the sole source for gas to facilities west of the project, it can only be abandoned when daily/nightly temperatures are above 40 degrees F. The abandonment is estimated by Laclede Gas to take 3 working days, however the commission does not warrant the information from Laclede Gas.
