Frequently Asked Questions

What is the purpose of tonight's meeting?

The purpose of tonight's meeting is to inform and educate the general public on the traffic management plan for the roadway improvements project along the U.S. Route 50 (Whitton Expressway) corridor from Monroe Street to Clark Avenue. It is also an opportunity for the property owners and general public to ask any questions on the plan.

How will traffic be affected?

Traffic will be greatly affected. The bridge work will require closures at Jackson Street and Chestnut Street as well as a closure of the Clark Avenue overpass. Bridge and grading work on U.S. Route 50 may require detours and closures as well. Not all closures will occur at the same time and MoDOT is working closely with the City of Jefferson, Cole County and emergency management services to minimize impacts when possible.

When will the work take place?

The work is scheduled to begin in late 2014 and take approximately two years to complete.

How was this traffic management plan developed?

The plan was developed by MoDOT staff working closely with the City of Jefferson, Cole County, Lincoln University, Jefferson City Public Schools, consultants, contractors, and emergency management services. The plan is subject to change based on traffic flow, weather, or other unknown factors that can influence construction.
