



Route 133 Realignment in Meta Osage County

Frequently Asked Questions

What is the purpose of tonight's public hearing?

The purpose of tonight's public hearing is to gather public input about plans to realign Route 133 near Meta. The realignment begins approximately a half mile south of Route B at Meta and continues south for about a half mile. The work is being done to improve safety by reducing the grade of a steep hill at this location. Route 133 will also be resurfaced from Route B to Route 52 as part of a separate project that will take place at the same time.

How will traffic be affected?

The realignment work will require closing the roadway and detouring traffic.

When will work take place?

The project is scheduled to begin in mid 2012 and should be completed within three months.

Will additional right of way be needed to construct this project?

Some property and easements may need to be acquired for this project. For those property owners affected, we encourage you to reference a MoDOT brochure titled "Pathways for Progress." This brochure outlines the process and should answer most of your questions. If you have questions after viewing the brochure, our Right of Way staff will be pleased to assist you. What is the project cost?

The realignment work will cost about \$660,000 to construct. The separate resurfacing project will cost about \$134,000 to construct.
