Purpose of Today's Meeting

The meeting today includes detailed displays that show the preliminary range of alternative alignments. We need your input to help determine which alternatives should be considered. Please review the information available tonight and give us your feedback about where the future Route 63 should go.

What are some possible options that could result from the study?

No-Build:

The study may show no need to make major improvements to Route 63.

Rehabilitation/Expansion of the Existing Highway:

The study may show a need for adding additional lanes along the existing Route 63 to meet future traffic demands. Some examples of this may include:

- o Climbing lanes on steep hills similar to the section south of Westphalia
- o Center turn lanes through some of the communities
- o Alternating passing lanes through various sections of the corridor
- o Possible four-lane highway on the existing alignment through sections of the corridor

Relocation of Highway:

The study may show Route 63 needs to be completely relocated from its existing alignment, or portions of the route need to be relocated. This could also include additional lanes along the corridor.
