A major highway project in Kansas City was completed Dec. 18 on budget and six months ahead of schedule. The \$245 million kcICON project included the reconstruction and rehabilitation of 4.7 miles of Interstate 29/35 and improving 18 outdated interchanges. A new landmark, cable-stay Christopher S.
