New statistics show Missourians are doing a great job of sharing the road. Between 2006 and 2008, the number of fatal truck crashes decreased 19 percent. MoDOT attributes the drop to better road conditions and increased law enforcement and education. This week is Operation Safe Driver Week, and MoDOT reminds drivers to buckle up, focus on driving, obey speed limits and keep a safety cushion around trucks.
