MoDOT has issued a draft list of transportation projects to be funded by remaining economic stimulus funds. Public briefings were held around the state March 10 to share the project information with citizens. The list of projects and a map showing their location can be found at [www.modot.org](http://www.modot.org). Work is under way on 37 economic stimulus projects totaling about \$91 million.
