

Hi, this is Sally Oxenhandler with your MoDOT Minute.

The Missouri Highways and Transportation Commission has approved a final list of transportation projects to be funded with economic recovery funds. The transportation improvements are expected to directly or indirectly support 22,000 jobs. The project package totals \$577 million, slightly more than the \$525 million MoDOT has left to spend. That's because the department built in additional money to ensure it will qualify for redistribution of funds from other states if they become available. The list of projects and a map showing their location can be found at modot.org.

To make work zones better and safer, MoDOT is asking travelers to fill out a survey rating the construction areas they drive through on state highways. Motorists can weigh in on advanced warnings, speed limits, timeliness and safety. The survey is available at modot.org.
