MoDOT has released its list of the top 10 work zones to look out for this summer. These projects are the ones most likely to slow you down, so it's best to avoid them if you can, especially during peak hours. The list, which can be found at [modot.org](http://modot.org), is ranked in order of impact based on traffic volume, amount of work and level of delay.

MoDOT has begun using Twitter to provide transportation information such as traffic updates in St. Louis, Kansas City and along I-70. The micro-blog lets the agency provide real-time traffic alerts and other important news electronically in 140 characters or less.
