

Frequently Asked Questions

Question: *What keeps the area water covered?*

Answer: Underground water seepage in various areas.

Question: *Can any part of the entire area be planted in crops?*

Answer: Areas C and B cannot. Area A usually has water on the majority of it. The only logical place for any type of crop would be the southern portion of Area A, south of the ditch.

Question: *Is the water stagnate or does it flow?*

Answer: The water flows from Area A to Area C via a weir and then flows to a ditch on the east side of the property and eventually to the Missouri River.

Question: *Is there power available?*

Answer: There are power poles along the north side of the property.

Question: *What is the depth of water?*

Answer: The easterly end of Area C (in the wetlands) is approximately 10-15 feet deep while the westerly end is shallower. In Area A the water is approximately 10 feet deep near the weir and then about 5 feet south of that. Of course, the depth can fluctuate during certain times of the year.
