



Interstate 64 Corridor Lighting East of Kingshighway to Poplar Street Bridge

Why are Improvements Needed on Interstate 64?

There are over two hundred light poles on Interstate 64 from east of Kingshighway to the Poplar Street Bridge. Many are located on the double decked structure that was built in the early 1970's and have deteriorated beyond the point of simply repairing them. Most of these light structures have already been removed over the last few years. However, all the lighting throughout the corridor needs to be completely restored.

What Improvements Will MoDOT Accomplish?

The existing bridge-mounted light fixtures are difficult to maintain. Crews will install high mast towers located on the ground throughout the corridor, which will be easier to construct and maintain in the future. The high mast tower lighting is much more efficient and takes the place of several old light poles.

How Will Traffic Be Impacted?

Most of the improvements will occur during night-time hours, which will have minimum impacts to I-64 and surrounding local streets. Short-term lane and ramp closures will be needed to remove existing light poles and install new high mast light towers along the interstate.

When Will Construction Begin?

Construction is expected to begin in Fall 2012 and is expected to be complete in Spring 2013.
