REQUEST FOR LETTERS OF INTEREST FOR DESIGN-BUILD SERVICES

The Missouri Department of Transportation (MoDOT) is soliciting Letters of Interest from companies interested in providing Design-Build services for the I-64 Daniel Boone Bridge Project in St. Charles and St. Louis counties.

The project's primary purpose is to replace a deficient bridge with a new Missouri River Bridge connecting St. Charles and St. Louis counties. It will also provide a bicycle/pedestrian facility connecting the KATY Trail to the Monarch Levee Trail.

One Design-Build team will be selected to design and construct the project consistent with the Record of Decision, approved by FHWA in November 2011. In addition to design and construction, quality management, maintenance of traffic and environmental management may be included as part of the contract. MoDOT will use a Best Value selection process to evaluate the ability of the Design-Build proposers to meet or exceed the following project goals:

- Deliver the project within the programmed budget of \$125 million.
- Construct a Missouri River bridge that can be reasonably maintained to provide more than a century of useful life.
- Maximize the mobility, capacity and safety improvements in the corridor when construction is complete.
- Minimize and mitigate construction impacts and maximize work zone safety to customers through construction staging and communication efforts.
- Complete the project no later than July 1, 2016.

An informational meeting is scheduled from 1 p.m. to 4 p.m., Monday, January 9, 2012, at MoDOT's St. Louis Office, 1590 Woodlake Drive, Chesterfield, MO 63017.

It is anticipated the Request for Qualifications (RFQ) will be released this same day. At the meeting, a presentation will be made on the project, followed by a question and answer period and time for networking.

Firms interested in receiving I-64 Daniel Boone Bridge Design-Build information should send a one-page **Letter of Interest** to MoDOT by registered mail, or similar delivery method that indicates proof of receipt, no later than Wednesday, January 4, 2012, to ensure that you receive all information. The Letters of Interest will allow MoDOT to compile a list of interested companies for notices and any announcements relating to the I-64 Daniel Boone Bridge Design-Build Project.
