



St. Charles County — 2009

1. **Route 364 east and west of Harvester Road.** During this project, an additional mile of Route 94 will be upgraded to a limited access roadway, with an overpass for Harvester Road and one-way outer roads. Permanent lane restrictions and some non-peak lane closures. Includes weekend and day work. The project continues until fall 2009 and will impact about 44,000 drivers daily.
2. **Route 94 from 5th Street to Route B.** Crews will repair pavement and put on an asphalt overlay. Drivers can expect to have the road reduced to one lane with flaggers moving traffic during the work. This project runs from summer to fall 2009.
3. **Route 40/61.** Crews are upgrading the route to interstate standards from west of Lake St. Louis Blvd to I-70. This project will eliminate all at-grade crossings and construct a new interchange at Prospect Road. Drivers can expect permanent road closures and some non-peak lane closures until the project is complete in fall 2009.
4. **Interstate 70 from west of Route K to Lake St. Louis Blvd.** Crews will remove and replace asphalt along the interstate. All work will take place at night, during non-peak traffic hours. This project runs from spring to summer 2009.
5. **Interstate 70 from 5th Street to Route 61.** Crews will upgrade traffic signal systems along outer roads and ramps. Drivers can expect some non-peak lane closures from winter 2009 to fall 2009.
6. **Interstate 70 Outer Road between Route 79 and Route K.** Crews will place an asphalt overlay on the outer roads. During the work, flaggers will move traffic along the outer roads, which will be restricted to one traffic lane. This project runs from summer 2009 to fall 2009.
7. **Route 94 north of Defiance.** Crews will rehabilitate the bridge over Femme Osage Creek. Drivers can expect permanent reductions to one lane with traffic regulated by a temporary traffic signal. The project will run from summer 2009 to fall 2009.
8. **Route A from Interstate 70 to Route 61.** Crews will rehabilitate pavement and place an asphalt overlay on the route. Drivers can expect non-peak travel hour lane closures. This project will run from summer to fall 2009.
9. **Route C from Interstate 70 to the Mississippi River.** Crews will place an asphalt overlay on the route. Flaggers will direct traffic during non-peak hours, as lanes will be reduced to one lane during work. This work will take place in summer 2009.
10. **Route D from Callaway Fork west 1.2 miles.** This project will add shoulders to Route D. Drivers can expect to have the roadway reduced to one lane during non-peak hours. Flaggers will direct traffic during closures. This work will take place in spring 2009.
